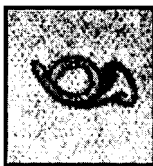

In this issue there are 12 types each of Nos. 16, 17, 18 and 19; 12 types of No. 20 and 20 types of No. 21. The differences are in the words of value.

Used values of Nos. 10, 12, 16-17, 19 and 21 are for specimens canceled in later period, 1888-1908. Those canceled before 1888 are usually worth considerably more. These six stamps were used until Mar. 31, 1908.

No. 19 comes on thin and thick paper. Same value used. Unused, thick paper ten times given value.

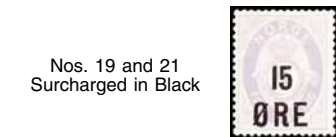

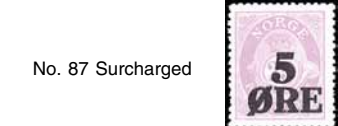
